This chart illustrates the match rate of Round 1 My School DC applicants broken down by grade level and how many schools they selected on their application. For example, the match rate of 1<sup>st</sup> grade applicants who selected 7 schools on their application is 68%.

The general trend in all grades is that the more schools a student selects on the application, the better the chances are for a match. However, My School DC recommends that families only select schools on their applications that they would like their students to attend.
